Mount St. Joseph University's Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program has an outstanding reputation, built on nearly 100 years of experience. Nursing majors at the Mount progress through a comprehensive program that includes a variety of classes, labs, and off-campus clinical experiences, preparing them to become effective patient advocates and leaders in diverse healthcare settings. Each year, four incoming students can earn a \$10,000 BSN scholarship (\$2,500 / year). BSN graduates can go further with graduate nursing certificates and advanced degrees. Nursing Faculty Loan Program (NFLP) funds are available for MSJ graduate nursing programs with an 85% loan forgiveness opportunity!

The BSN program can be completed in four years, with a three-year pathway available to high school students who complete select college credit plus or AP classes.


